18. Approve the resolution to terminate all participation under the School Employees' Health Benefits Program (NJ SEHBP) as follows;

Be it Resolved:

The East Hanover School District in the County of Morris hereby resolves to terminate its participation in the Medical Plan thereby canceling coverage provided by the School Employees' Health Benefits Program (N.J.S.A. 52:14-17. 25 et seq.) for all of its active and retired employees.

We shall notify all active employees of the date of their termination of coverage under the program.

We understand that the Division of Pensions and Benefits will notify retired employees of the cancellation of their coverage.

We understand that all COBRA participation will be notified by the Division of Pensions and Benefits and advised to contact our office concerning a possible alternative health plan.

We understand that this resolution shall take effect the first of the month following a 60-day period beginning with the receipt of the resolution by the School Employees' Health Benefits Commission.

Whereas the East Hanover Board of Education has received a proposal from Horizon Blue Cross Blue Shield of NJ for medical benefits that are "equal to or better than" those in the NJ SEHBP, with premium rates that are below the January 1, 2018 renewal of the SEHBP,

Therefore, the Board hereby approves a contract with Horizon Blue Cross Blue Shield of NJ for the period March 1, 2018, through June 30, 2019. (Doc. F-9)
